Title of the book

Author of the book

Number of pages in the book

Book category (fiction, non-fiction, biography, Christian fiction, auto-biography)

Setting(s) and time of the book

Description of the main characters in the book

Description of the plot

Describe the climax of the story

Brief summary of the story's ending

Conclude with your impression of the book

You will receive a quiz grade in language for this summary.
