Kindergarten and First Grade

It is important to continue to read aloud with your child even after they become independent readers. Children need to hear how good reading sounds by listening to good readers read. Students in these grade levels are striving to achieve the ability to read aloud and silently with fluency, accuracy, and comprehension.

DIRECTIONS:

Select five books your child would enjoy reading or being read to. Read them with your child and talk about the content. There is no need to complete written work at this point. Just spending time reading with your child and modeling good reading is the important thing. Students will talk about what they read when they return to school in the fall.

Let your child select the books to read with you. The list below provides examples. You do not have to read the books on the list. They are provided in case you need some to get started.
